MAN ON MOON

Sea of Tranquility-(U.P.I.), (O.&L.)-At 3:19pm Sunday, the 20th of July, 1969, the U.S. successfully put a manned spacecraft on the Moon (The theory of the "Green cheese" was appropriately disproven).

Houston gave the lunar module, Eagle the go ahead to touchdown on the moon. Later about 9:30pm, Neil Armstrong became the 1st human to set feet on the surface of the moon.

He was closely followed by Edwin Aldrin, and soon after began their work. They planted a U.S. flag with a message from 47 other nations. All this was transmitted from 240,000 miles away, and seen by almost every American citizen. The lunar walk lasted about 2½ hours & during that time they carried approx. eighty pounds of lunar soil back to their ship to be sent back to Earth.
