WORLD CLASS FRISBEE DOUBLES: Partners throw and catch a frisbee as many times in a row as they can without missing while keeping one foot inside a circular boundary at opposite sides of the field.

SERVING CHAMPIONSHIPS: One boys serves and the other boys stands inside the service box at the tennis court. As many times as they can in a period of one minute, the server hits the ball, and his partner catches it on the fly while still inside the service box.

THIS ONE HAS EYES EVENT: At the putting green, each partner alternates putts as they try to sink a "very" long putt in as few shots as possible.

WAUPACA COUNTRY CLUB CHIP AND RUN: Partners try to chip golf balls from one target area into another.

MINIATURE STRIKE ZONE EVENT: One partner attempts to pitch a hardball into a target area set up at home plate while the other boys retrieves the balls as fast as possible. Most strikes in one minute will earn the most points.

WHAT WILL THEY THINK OF NEXT EVENT: Partners stand at opposite ends of the flickerball goal and attempt to play catch through the goal with a flickerball as many consecutive times as possible in one minute.

SWISH! Both boys shooting at once trying to score as many points as possible. Two points for every shot outside the target area and one point for every successful shot inside the area.

WILLIAM TELL INSTANT-APPLESAUCE EVENT: One partner draws a card and the other boy attempts to hit the color on the target that matches the color on the card. Bows and arrows are the instruments of destruction to be used at the archery range.

READY ON THE RIGHT, READY ON THE LEFT, READY ON THE FIRING LINE: Both partners shoot at the same target attempting to get the highest score possible. Crack out those 22s at the rifle range.

MINNESOTA FATS POOL HUSTLING: An obstacle course on the pool table? You haven't done anything like this one before. Both partners alternate shots. (The rest of the rules will be given at the Rec Hall - if you are able to understand them on the first try, you get a bonus point!)

FASTEN YOUR SEAT BELTS: Partners are each seated in a playak in the swimmers area trying to play catch with a flickerball from a distance of twenty feet. Bathing suits optional.

TABLE TENNIS TARGET RALLY: Partners attempt to score points by hitting designated target areas on the table as they rally a ping pong ball at the Rec Hall. Try it - you'll like it!

BEAT THE CHAMPS: Target bowling combining speed, accuracy and timing at the tennis board by the side of the courts.

RINGER AROUND THE COLLAR: Partners attempt to score as much as possible at the horseshoe pit with an extra bonus for all ringers!

FIELD GOAL: Football punting for accuracy as one partner attempts to kick the ball into a target area worth points.

INSTANT ELECTROCUTION EVENT: One partner attempts to hit an overhead electric wire with a tennis ball and the other boy must catch the ball before it hits the ground. Game will be played at the side of the tennis courts. (Any team causing an area wide power failure will be penalized ten points!)

PYRAMID DEMOLITION DERBY: One partner sets up a pyramid of cups and his partner attempts to knock it down. Speed is the key. (Best pyramid wins the annual "King Tut" Award.)

GRAND PRIZE GAME: A game of skill and chance!

FUNGO: One partner hits the ball and attempts to have it land in a designated target area. Some areas are worth more than others. (Dave Kingman, stand aside!)
