

## GENERAL SCHEDULE FOR FIRST TWO DAYS OF CAMP

### SUNDAY

- 1:00 Busses arrive...staff and campers assemble at the horse-shoe for announcement of cabin assignments...campers go to their cabins with counselors to drop off gear (do not unpack)...remain in cabins until call to return to horse-shoe (about five minutes)
- 1:15 At the horseshoe, the table assignments will be read off ...everyone goes into the Dining Hall for lunch
- 1:45 After lunch, campers and counselors return to cabins to unpack trunks and duffels...all boys should remain with the cabin group... (see unpacking instructions!)
- 3:00 By about 3:00 the basic unpacking should be completed... keep the boys together and take a leisurely tour of the camp grounds...boys who have been here before can help direct the new boys as to interesting features or particular areas of the grounds
- 3:30 \*\* When finished with the tour, return to the cabin and pass out program sheets...explain the classes to the kids...help them make out a schedule...when finished with the schedule, take the kids out to a program area (basketball court, softball field, etc.) keep them active and busy until the call for the waterfront orientation
- 4:30 Everyone assembles at the top of the waterfront stairs for a brief orientation session explaining the use of the buddy board and boating area
- 5:15 Flag Lowering
- 5:30 Supper
- 6:15 Free Time on land and waterfront (no swimming) for one hour
- 7:15 Call to competition areas (see competition schedule)
- 8:20 Call to the horseshoe area for a brief campfire and a presentation by the dramatics department
- 8:45 Canteen...Return to cabins

## FIRST DAY SCHEDULE

Sunday Aft: Buses arrive, all staff assemble at buses to help kids unload and move to the horseshoe area

At the horseshoe we have a brief welcome to camp followed by the cabin assignments. Boys and their counselors go back to cabins for five minutes to drop off belongings, select bunks, and learn each other's names. Wait at cabins until the call is made to return to the horseshoe.

When call to return to horseshoe is made, please come as quickly as possible. At the horseshoe we will have the table assignments, and counselors will take the boys at their table into the Dining Hall. (No prayer at lunch today).

After lunch, everyone goes back to cabins to unpack and set up cabins. Please note the following:

1. Boys should have two sheets on bed
2. Proper dust cover over pillow tucked in on three sides
3. Shoes in shoe rack
4. Nothing on the floor or on rafters
5. Sleeping bags on top of back shelves
6. Clothes folded neatly (folds out) on shelves
7. No clothes on top side shelves
8. Nothing on window sills
9. Caution boys about writing on walls - repainting costs will come out of their canteen
10. Duffel bags should be placed inside of trunks when both are empty. Trunks should then be locked and placed neatly outside of cabin.

Boys who finish early can help the boys who are having trouble. Please supervise bed making and check the boys at each step along the way.

When everyone is finished, keep the cabin group together. You may use some of the athletic equipment in the field house to play catch, etc.

Once all of the cabins have finished unpacking and setting up, we will call everyone to the top of the waterfront for a brief orientation.

Depending on the time factor, additional plans for the afternoon will be provided.



Sunday Eve: After the call to flag and cabin reports, we will eat supper.

After supper there will be a short free time with all land areas open.

The call for cabin competition will be at 7:10. See schedule for staff assignments.

After the competition games (8:15) we will all go to the horseshoe area to meet the staff, sing some songs, and watch some skits. When the presentation at the horseshoe is over, everyone will go back to their cabins.

At the cabins, everyone takes a shower (please be sure that all boys have shower shoes - if they do not, take their name and size). After showers, go over the class schedules with the boys and assist them in planning out their schedules. This would also be a good time to discuss any cabin rules or policies that you intend to present.

The first night is a difficult one. Do not leave the cabin until the lights have been off and the boys have been quiet for at least 30 minutes.

#### SCHEDULE FOR MONDAY

Monday Morn: Wake up is at 7:30. Call to the flag is 7:55. Have the boys make their beds before flagpole and if all was picked up from the floor the night before, they could even start sweeping.

After breakfast is cabin clean-up. All boys are to report directly back to their cabin to help out. The clean-up lasts for 30 minutes.

Next is the call for cabin competition. See schedule for staff assignments.

After competition, everyone assembles at the horseshoe for an introduction to the class sign-up. Boys should bring their class sign-up sheets to the horseshoe.

All staff involved in the sign-up should meet in the Dining Hall at this time. Mike Euer will be checking out each boy, Mike Lurie will be directing traffic.



Staff assigned to areas should report to supervise campers once they are finished with the sign-up and swim checks.

Campers will all report to the Dining Hall to sign-up, then they will report down to the waterfront for swim checks, and then they will have a free time with all land areas open.

After lunch we move into the regular schedule!

#### EVENING PROGRAMS FOR THE WEEK

Monday: CABIN COMPETITION (followed by Cabin Campfires)

Staff should have campers collect wood for fires during the day on Monday. Marshmallows will be provided and staff should prepare something to do around the fire for about 45 minutes. (Just talking is fine, a story might be nice).

Tuesday: ALMOST ANYTHING GOES

Staff on duty will be officiating competition between cabins in crazy games and events. Information will be presented well in advance to those staff members.

Wednesday: STAR WARS PROGRAM

Everyone assembles at the horseshoe for announcement of teams, distribution of shirts, and initial events including the TUG O' WAR.

Thursday: CABIN NIGHT (Cabins 1,3,5,7 go to town)

All other cabins prepare activities and check them out with Ron. Cookout for supper, and the rest of the evening is yours to plan.

Friday: BAILING AND BOATING!

Competition teams have waterfront activities after free period.

Saturday: Movie (BENJI)

Sunday: MOMENT OF MADNESS (by Star Wars teams)

Games and events around the Rec Hall. Staff meeting later at 9:45.
