- Q. Why are you going to the Wisconsin Dells this year?

- Q. What is Ishnala, and why are you having dinner there?
- A. For all the years we sent boys to the Dells as a reward for being an Early Bird (registered for the following camp season "early"), an "advance team" was sent to the Dells to set up camp pitch tents, set up the camping kitchen, etc. To thank the advance team (usually including Wayne Towne), Manny would provide extra money to Wayne to treat the advance team to a nice supper club dinner.
