

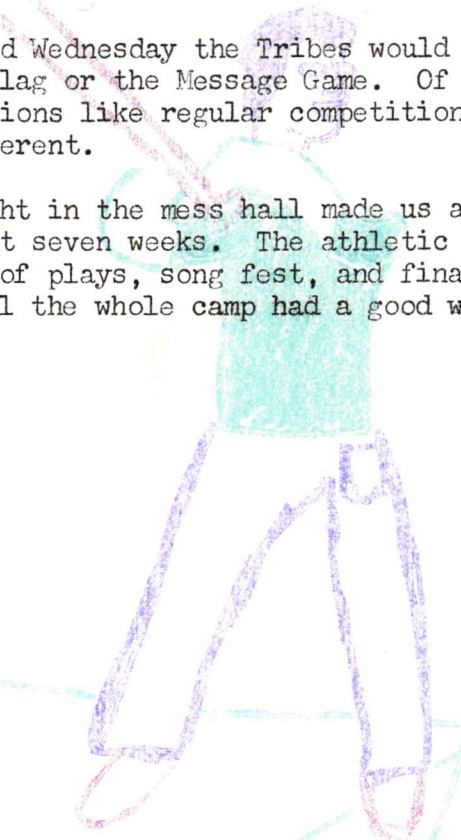
COMPETITION TRAIL
