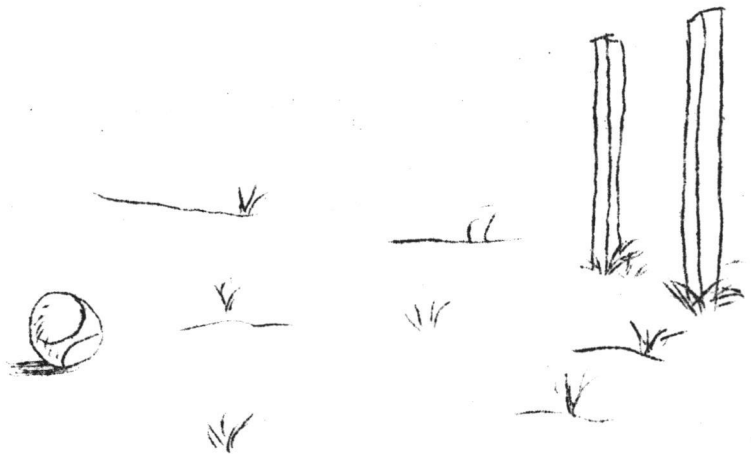

OLYMPICS

The 1972 Camp Waupaca Olympics was unique in several ways. For the first time in the camp's history the games were expanded to cover a two-day period. The competition was heated (as was the weather) and when all was said and done only 44 points separated the eight competing nations. Defending champion "ITALY" finished with a flourish to retain the title. Congradulations to Coach Marty Gartzman and all of the representatives from Italy!

The preparations for Olympics began several days before the flags were unfurled at the waterfront. Special credit goes to Jessie Clingingsmith for spending several days designing the Olympic shirts and drawing the silk screen patterns that were used to make them. Craig Fuller once again appeared at the opening ceremonies as the Greek God Zeus who presides over the Olympics. He administered the Olympic oath and sent the athletes off to the fields.

The games were highlighted by many spectacular performances. Under the direction of Coach Arnie Feldstein, Taiwan raced to an early lead with impressive team victories in field sports and at the waterfront. They led throughout the competition on Friday and retired for the evening in first position. Not to be forgotten though, Italy and the USSR struck back with key victories on the fields during the Saturday morning and afternoon competition. A first place finish in the Track Meet and the Field Sports clinched the championship for Italy.

It is difficult to single out only a few boys for special recognition. Dozens of gold, silver and bronze medals were awarded

in the special award ceremonies in the Dinning Hall, and all of the winners made large contributions to their nation. Two of the largest contributions came from the gold medal winners in the grueling track and regular pentathlons. Bruce Cohen of Japan came out on top of the eight competitors in the track pentathlon, and Mark Field of France headed the competition for the gold medal in the regular pentathlon. The spirit that led these boys on to victory highlighted the 1972 Camp Waupaca Olympics.
