

ON THE FIELDS

COMPETITION

Good coaching and a lot of hustle and teamwork enabled the American League (I) champions--Mafia--to assemble a record of 14 wins, 4 losses, 2 ties on their way to the most outstanding performance by any competition team during the summer of 1973. After a shaky start, Mafia put together an eight game winning streak during which time they pulled away from the rest of the league. Following injuries to several key players, the Superdollioliefoes fell to the cellar. The Hustlers were never able to get untracked -- and the late charge of the Massacre Machine vaulted them into second place, but at no time allowed them to challenge for the lead. Mafia was just too strong for all of their competition during the first four weeks.

In the National League (I) race, a late charge by El Hot Dogs allowed them to catch and pass the Rip-Offs in an exciting photo finish. Led by Mike Green and Ben Fox and Larry Gordon and Howard Nixon, El Hot Dogs won two crucial basketball games late

in the schedule to clinch first place.

In the Federal League, it was Schviggers all the way. A late upsurge by Chinkas de Madraes fell far short as Schviggers held onto first place all through the scheduled games from the first day of competition to the last. Good coaching and teamwork were a prime factor in their success.

The comeback of the year was made by the champions of the American League during the first two weeks of the second four. The Pimpy Honkers came from last place with a record of 0-3 to win 6 and tie 1 of their last seven games and clinch the title by a single point over Harry's Bar & Grill. The Sundance Kids who led the league for most of the period fell to third place in the shuffle.

One of the wildest races took place in the National League during the second four as the first three teams were separated by only two points when all was said and done. After the first four games on the schedule, all four teams were tied for first place with identical records of 2-2. The competition continued to be even throughout, with most of the games being played under the pressure of knowing that the outcome would determine the first place team that morning. It was finally Hoke's He-Men who squeezed through on the final day to win the league championship.

In the Federal League during the second four, Mama Lapingo dominated play throughout the schedule. Kryshkies Kishkies remained hot on their tails until the very end when a late rally by Besamiculo vaulted them up into a second place tie with the Kishkies. Stopping Mama Lapingo was the name of the game--and teams found that a most difficult task.

In all, it was an excellent year for competition on the fields. The "Coaching Experiment" was a huge success and will certainly become a part of the regular camp competition program

in the years to come. On the fields we saw better athletics than we have seen at camp in over 10 years. The new crew of CITs made the Federal League stronger than ever and more competitive in every area. Hopefully, as the quality of athletics steadily rises at camp, so will sportsmanship and teamwork.

TRIBES

A first place finish in the Tug O War and the Pursuit relay was not enough for Pawnee as they attempted to do the impossible. Coming from last place to challenge for first, Pawnee was just nosed out by Comanche in four weeks of close tribal competition. The weekly combination games and evening capture the flags kept the teams close all the way through Giant Tribe Sunday. A big win in the Giant Relay gave Comanche just enough to hold on. All of the Grand Sachems did an excellent job: Perry Becker for the victorious Comanche, Ken Robbins for the Illini, Mike Lurie for the Pawnee, and Craig Clotiaux for the Blackfeet.

INTER-CAMP BASEBALL

A new addition to the camp program this summer was intercamp baseball. The camp hardball team played four contests, two each with Royal Oaks and Mikquano--coming out victorious in all four games. Pitchers Howard Gartzman, Marty Shabelman and Lee Freedman kept opposing batters guessing as our defense held firm and our offense supplied more than enough runs to win a half dozen or more games. Next summer we hope to expand our hardball program and feature many more games for both our older and our younger baseball players.

In softball competition, we also remained undefeated for the summer. The American League All-Stars demolished Camp Mikquano early during the first four weeks (31-0). In a rematch during the Early Bird Trip, we played our 11-Under team against many of their older boys and still edged out a 5-4 win in seven innings. Together with our initial 14-0 slaughter over Royal Oaks and a later 24-2 massacre over Camp Micquano (both in hard-ball)--we displayed an overall dominance in all inter-camp competition on the diamonds.
