1975 Champs: BLUE TEAM

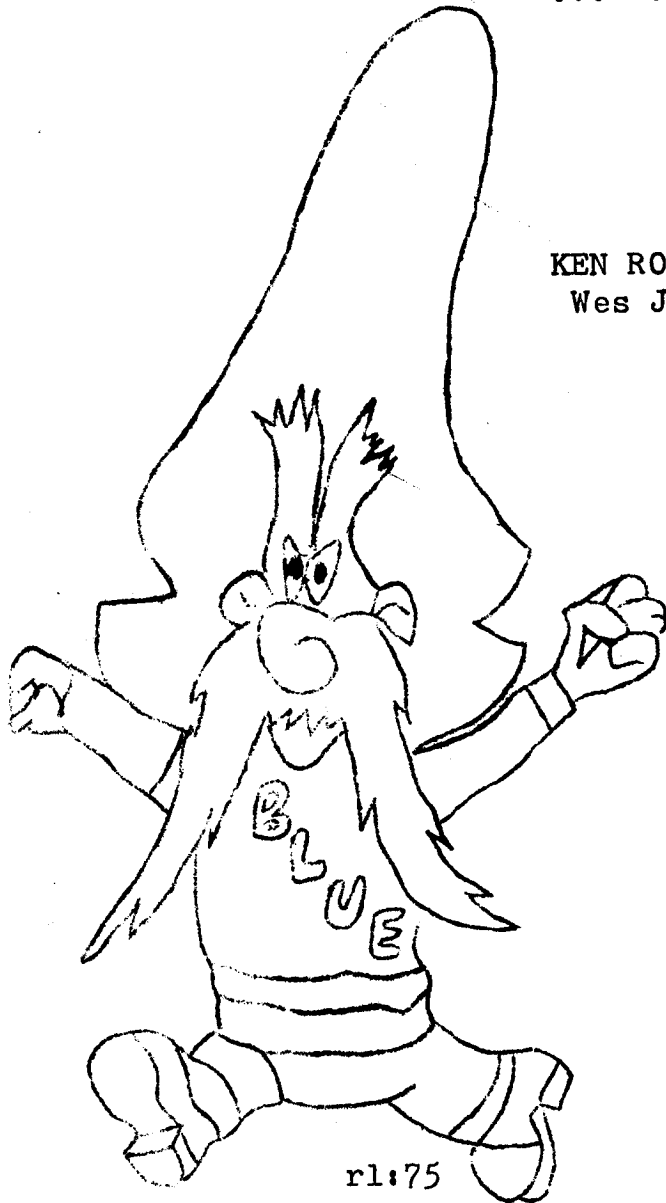

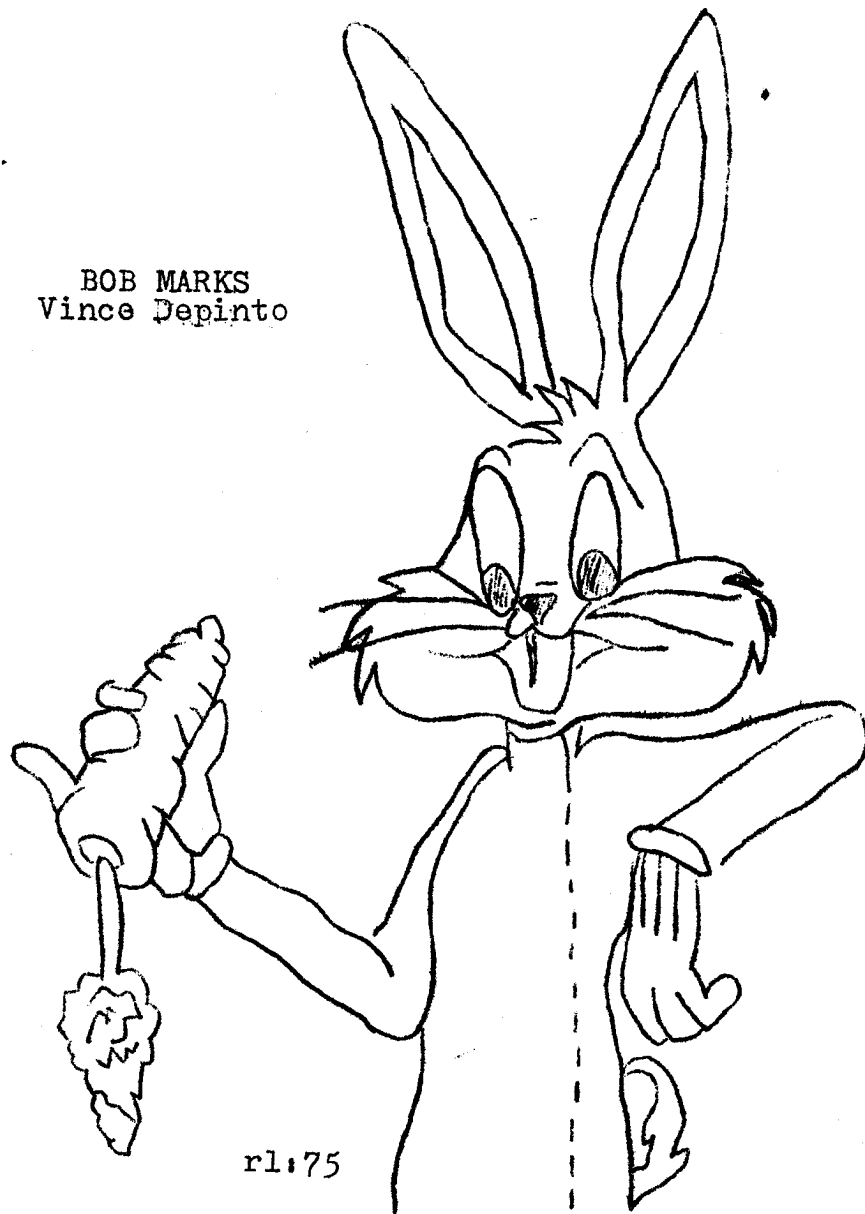
