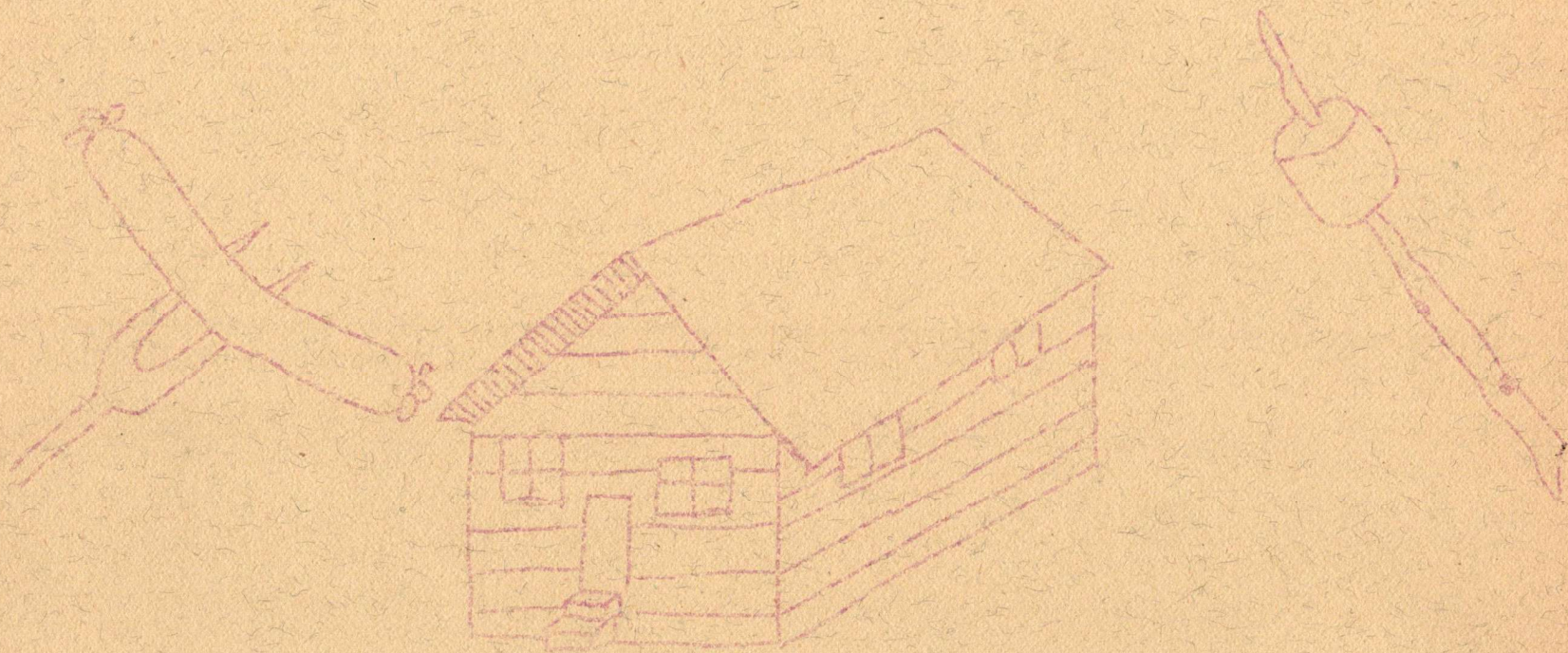


FACES
