Steve Wauty helpsHe is ably assisted by Bob Mowen, his mother, and Warren Metzдорff, (although Warren is only a weekend guest.)...Even kitchen girls help out mopping cabins, cleaning shelves, and in general, removing the months of neglect from the still dormant camp...Some familiar faces come up to camp...old faces from the past visit for weekends...many memories here...some will probably rerun for life...Jason Belenke looks at his calendar and realizes that there are only three weeks left before camp begins!...The new counsellors begin arriving and we meet some new and old faces...Bob Mowen has his Little Lists that keep multiplying...its like gremlins, don't feed Bob after midnight or his lists get longer for work assignments...Staff have fun with mowing the golf bunkers, painting, fixing roofs...John Everman says one night before dinner, "C'mon guys, lets just move the top off this cesspool, then we'll be done...Mike Scharmer takes one look at the contents and faints...We meet Action Al, Jumpin' Jim, and Debtful Dennis...Surprise from Really Old Ron...Warren and Paul decide to invite Manny to a Patio party on the new cement slab by Cabin 14/15...Staff get to know each other at Juniors for pool and chatting...Some even try Wally World...Meanwhile Mike Jelinek gets his report card and says, "Whew!"...Ed Schotz promises his Mom he'll try not to throw his glasses so much this summer...Matt says goodbye to his brother Josh Silverstein...Mothers all over the Chicagoland area comb the Army-Navy stores for camouflage tee shirts, headbands, etc....Grandmas everywhere start their lists of what goodies to "smuggle" up to camp for their Favorite Grandson...Soon it is Sunday, June 22 and at 4:30 AM, Neal

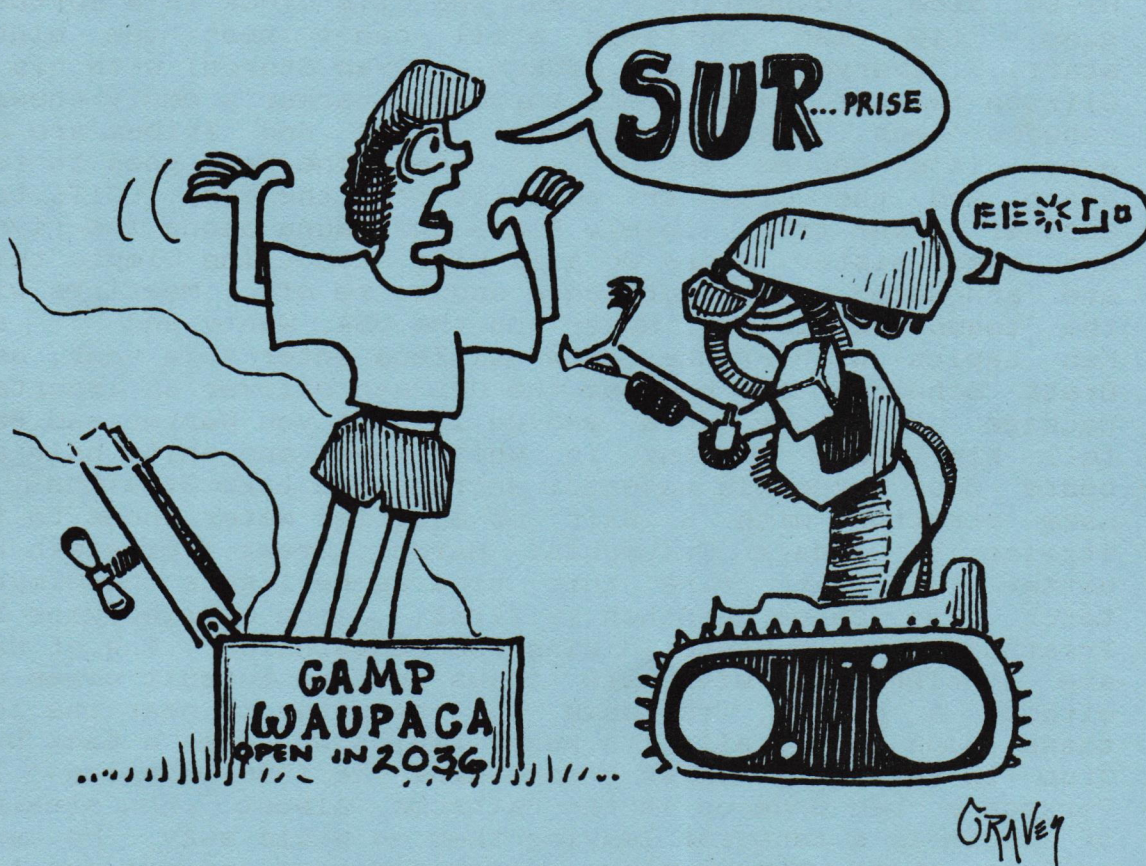
Silins opens his desk drawer to take out his camp photo albums...in another home, Mike Shea packs his own bow and arrows for camp and Gregg Feinstein says, "This year I'll catch BIG MOE!"...Parents wake their children and tell them the big day is here...one last meal of your favorite food, doughnut, or breakfast cereal and its off to the buses at Old Orchard...The buses are early as Paul and Chris arrive to board the campers...some look too old to be campers...Costello, did you bring your razor?... "My goodness, you guys just keep getting taller while we get wider," Frog says...Everyone says their goodbyes, "Don't forget to feed the dog, cat and parakeet"...Your Aunt or next door neighbor kisses you goodbye...Your little sister says she'll miss you..your big sister says, "Glad your leaving, runt!"...You stick your tongue out at her but later feel a little bad about it...The buses pull out but where is Cole Klapman?? Eric Fine says he heard he was coming up late...It' a flying bus ride...the M & M's that is...Soon the ride is over after pulling through big towns like Weyauwega, Fond du Lac, and Oshkosh...pretty landscape, lots of corn and cows and few hills...Soon we pass under the gates of Camp Waupaca and we're Off to a great start...Horseshoe for everyone as we see new counsellors, new hairdos, new nurses...We meet Mike and Ron, get our cabin assignments and start unpacking..."It's time for lunch, WORSH up and into the mess Hall for another big, exciting lunch," Mike Euer bellows..."Wait a minute," Jon Adam Kroll says, "It can't be ANOTHER Waupaca lunch...we just got here!"...nonetheless we pile into the Mess Hall for hamburgers, fries, and home made cole slaw...We now have Three Piano Players at camp, Bob Mowen, Mike Lens, and Rob Heath...never before has so much talent been used on so few, for such a price...how do we do it? VOLUME!...Its Waupaca Squares wioth celebrities from the Cubs, Sox, South America, rock and roll stars...Its Staff superstars where we watch the staff attempt the difficult cups and cards marathon and the dreaded Puck Off...Its the Message Game the next night, it's snow problem and Tommy Flanagan are clues along with Grandma's sweater...and dark color shirts win.....Mike and Paul announce the start of yet another Camper-Counsellor Tennis Match...Ron says that it will never finish...Everyone asks someone to play...even Ken Lapins is approached...Dan Oseran moans, "Ohhhh my...will I get to play?"...The camp sings again and after Hava Nagila, Robert Resnick offers the reason why it is difficult, "The Het is the sound that makes the Hava in Hava Nagila."...Dennis Bravik saves a bird from Cabin 5...New table assignments...Dave Hagar asks if he has to have the same kid twice...Mike asks that David Euer not "set by the garbage disposal."...CITs go to town! and meet two girls on bicycles that are either desperate or great athletes for they peddle all over town to try to keep up with

us...We see Raw Deal, have pizza, the Dairy Queen, and sing in the bus all the way home with Eric Goldstein's "hmemenememenenenmeneme"...We have our hot dogs indoors a one night followed by the movie, Vision Quest...a playak salesman comes during the middle of the movie and Warren, Manny, and Bob test it..."Its worse than the Titanic Bob admits after disembarking...Lisa the nurse licks David Weitzenfeld's glasses, and tells him he'll like it...There is a big free swim boys, the tennis class, the archery class and the baseball/basketball class have bneen there all afternoon already...Cabin B in the village made of Moschin, Thake, and Charles order fifty pounds of nails and pneumatic hammers to finish their remodel. Adam asks if he can move a wall and build a terrace..It's Sagamore Night and the wise sages of the camp answer the difficult questions put to them by the campers...Gregg Feinstein tries to light a fire when the Indians arrive, slightly damp and we hear about the great wet father and his fire water from Chiefs Dudzak, Hager, Scharmer and Brauer...Classes are in full operation...Jason Charles builds a fabulous step stool...John Torshen begins his losing competition game slump...Jeremy Parker talks about wierd things in his sleep...David Euer brings a lawn chair into Cabin 6..."Tic Tic!!!!" Dave Harer yells, "They just wait for me!" he cries...Scott Macomber and Mike Shea puncture new holes in the archery targets with their bows...CITs go to the Chain o Lakes Water Ski Show...Tremendous! The great pyramid act ends up with one skier still up...The CITs meet those girls again...Jelinek and Rubin tell the manager of the Rosa Theatre to rope off five rows for them and thier girls...A mini archery tournament one night yields Cole Klapman as winner...Its Bailing and Boating and Jon Seed does well in the playak relay...Tennis Tourney proceeding well...Gregg Feinstein, Jeff Ptak, AJ Levin, and Mike Jelinek have "Bathroom Olympics" for time!...Pawnee wins the boating races...Sand castle building on the beach yields some interesting results...figures of prominent Waupaca celebrities and their features are highlighted in the sand sculpture...Its Talent Night and Resnick and Joy & Lisa wow the crowd with their rendition of "I Wanna Be a Cowboy..."...Ricky Sprotz and Brett Schwartz make a mess with the "Average Meal at Waupaca" with their hand puppet...Purvis, Blurvis, and Clervis re-appear...Dan Oseran and friends sing, "I Wanna be an Expo..."...Ed Schotz loses his glasses and enters the Academy of Science for his brillant detective work, (They were on Steve Wanty's head all the time, Ed)...Ryan Jacobson builds great back scratchers...Mitch and Rick play ping pong without paddles!...A few campouts go out and light rain make them ever so much fun!...The Camp goes to town...CITs to Weasels and the park, movie and Dairy Queen...They buy out a little

girl's lemonade stand and get the police to inquire of John Everman, "Who's in charge of this group?" Everman replies, "The short fat man in the khaki trousers, (meaning the Frog)"...Swimming classes going well...Mitch Lautenslager falls off a mini bike, though...It's Sports Six for Tribes...Eric Goldstein has a headache about his tribe...Fine organizes everything for Pawnee, they have scorecards, etc. for each activity...The Fourth of July begins with a high ho silver and a puff of smoke..exhaust smoke as Paul Revere tells us the British are coming, my horse is in the shop!..After a normal day the Mess Hall is transformed into the Fine Arts Complex...Curtains, lights, seats...Three One Act Plays presented, Ninja Liberty, Jason's 4th of July, and The Statue of Liberty meets God ... RESNICK...CITs go to town...not the little town of Waupaca but the metropolis of Stevens Point to see Karate Kid II, or Running Scared...Singing all the way home with melodies like "Jeremiah Was a Bullfrog...Its all camp MONOPOLY and campers dash about trying to buy the camp...Some river trips go out and the beautiful Crystal River is paradise to all who travel its clear clean course...paradise to all who don't lose paddles, that is...Cabin 12 gets a mirrored ball and disco lights...They play Meatloaf 24 hours non-stop...Jelinek calls "Hello, Hello, I'm Scott Fox!...Ron Lavine gives Steve Wanty a calendar so he knows what days to do the Statistics with Jon Torshen...Josh Reingold has an unusual shirt that reads, "I'm so happy I could ----."...Warshauer dives into home during a competiton game...He"s a ref though...But the call

was safe...Some bingo and more great prizes...Bobby Hirsch gets tickled and screams with delight...Those unlucky boys who lose the horsengoggles have to stack...some lose all the time...Other staff set up questions while boys are away from the table...Cabin 12 gets raided one night...Al Genender and Jeff Ptak are hit by softballs in one game; great sound effects...Cabin 9 has cannon ball sound effects of their own!...Gavin Greene tosses his cookies one night cause he is laughing so hard...Mike Jacobs mumbles in his sleep to Costello...Jim DeVries punts Dave Weitzenfeld out Cabin 7's door...It's Vegas Night! Yes there are some "high winds" in the neighborhood...It's horseracing and that tape, money cubes, and dealer Dudzak being crammed into the corner with HI-LO dice...Counsellor's clean the CITs clock in a softball game, (19 man outfield still can't beat the mighty staff)... "Everyone loves STURCHIE (Ryan Sturch) with his Ty Clinton haircut...Adam Kroll borrows Scharmer's empty chewing tobacco cans...Its the Pursuit Relay and Tribes are all over...It's Pawnee led by Eric Fine...The Camp goes to town again and the CITs try to split from the camp...CITs take another river trip...lovely Flora and Fauna along the river, and their sister, Clora Dora is nice, too...The Olympic teams are announced at the horseshoe and we're off...Meetings with the teams are slated...Hager and the USA, Wanty and Ken Lapins with France...How wil Zeus enter this year, asks Brett Schwartz as he sees the UPS man deliver an important package..."Say one word and we'll kill you Warren and Paul tell him...Next morning in white sheet and white hair and beard Zeus makes his majestci entrance on Lake Stratton...ON Lake Stratton with a pair of Sjoffles water shoes to the strains of Aida's Triumphant March...Gregg Feinstein has better luck with fire this time as he lights the Olmpic torch...The Canoe Marathon is first...Jason Charles wins the Triathalon, Dave Costello wins the Pentathalon...Tug of Wars are a nightmare with six teams but the Pursuit comes off without a hitch...its down to the water to hear the long thank yous and finally its Kenny Lapins who does a back body drop in Lake Stratton as France wins the 1986 Olympics...Tom Berkson's bed ends up in the bathroom, almost...Ron steals 5 of Cabin 12's fans for leaving them on while away...He can't believe there are so many...Jelamania runs rampant and Alex Jacobs gets caught up in it to at the flagpole one morning ripping off his shirt...First four weekers pack and the Early Birds get ready for their action filled trip...Mike the bus driver threatens to break the legs of any camper who uses the back door...Arrive at Noah's Ark Amusement Park...Where's Mike Euer for lunch?...~Torshen keeps his white shirt on his matching white body all day...Where's Scott Levine?...At the top of the waterslide?...Let's go!Where's Rob Resnick's clothes?...Tent assignments...Its supper then to the Tommy

Bartlett Water-Ski-Stage Show...Ricky Spritz, Scott Fox, and Jason Charles skip seats although we have the best seats we've ever had in 20 years!...Ed Schotz buys a Wisconsin stuffed mosquito...Charles and Jelinek buy lighted fluorescent earrings...



..Back at camp, the first four weekers are packing...Goodbye ya'all...see ya next summer..there are a few tears in the eyes of the staff...Is it sentiment? or the onions from the hamburgers?...The second four weekers check their calendars and they realize its time for Camp at last! ...Howie Fleischer had wanted to come to camp but had summer school...too bad they cancelled your class, Howie!...Others had Little League, drivers ed...Warren goes nuts with bed counts and assignments..The smart staff take that Saturday OFF!...Ty says,"Whew what a day's work! Tougher than the Army!...The big buses arrive and the families of all meet Chris Brauer, Ken Lapins, and Lisa Albert..This bus ride is a lot quieter than the first four weekers was--No flying M & Ms...A short ride into paradise and the buses pull through the gates once again!...There off!..Cabin assignments, lunch, new friends..."I want a top bunk says Andy Ettinger..."Hey! Aren't I in an older cabin yet??"...asks Jon Venetos...Hey you need a haircut already, Jon!...The wetnoses have arrived and Lapins has a contest for them....Winner is Robert Berland for asking "Do we use real bullits in the Blue & White War...New competition teams are announced...Chris Thake is a Captain???...Karl Ader punches a fish in the head---Another staff does, too and is momentarily hospitalized with scales in his hand...Drexelmania takes hold as Danny rips a shirt up at the flagpole...Steve Wanty shows his tan from the knees down because he always wears his wet suit...Red White & Blue Track Meet ands there are plenty of winners...CITs announce events---"Torshen: Crabwalk here!...Jeff Hershcleb installs a new ski pier...Jeff Bloomberg says he's bored one day at Waterskiing...Staff is only to happy to oblige and blindfold him & tie his shoes together...Gregg Feinstein de-hooks himself on the waterfront...Costello, Sills & Kaufman run over a playak with terrified Ricky Manelis on board...Competition is called...It's Mike Euer's favorite announcement...Brett Schwartz organizes his chicken McNuggets plate one dinner in a superlative magazine-like fashion...Mike Shcarmer listens to that blasted ALABAMA tape for the 3,000th time!...Somebody burn that thing!... Eric Waxman promises he'll run each morning, but never makes it out of bed..tomorrow, he says...CITs go to town...Gee, it's quiet in the Dining Hall without them, isn't it?...The kitchen girls Valerie and Lisa hang out at the beach and get slammed into the water by bullys on the raft...Sam Golper wakes up, expels gas, then goes back to sleep...Cabin 5 will tell you!...Jason Charles plays a loud chord on the piano and its yet another grace...Baby Cakes Marder makes another trip to the infirmary...Manny announces at a meal: Boys, we

Mike loses it one night...wandering around a campground at 4AM...Chefs go crazy as we prepare for Oriental Night...personalized fortune cookies...You will be arm wrestled by Mike Jelinek & he'll break both of your arms...Delicious food, Eric Schneider, Scott Eggener accompany big bad Sumo Schwartz but are beat by the Drexler bros & friends Ben Barnett. and Paul Hollander do the chinese rope tug...1/3 of the camp goes to town...to the bowling, pizza...oops, Hardees...then Dairy Queen...Trivial Challenge is next and we are divided into two divisions Mess Hall won by Coconut Ken Mazursky, Danny Schwab, Scott Zeller all are smiling...and Raspberry...Jordan Batt, Danny Barbakoff, Matt Glick and Danny Shapiro all are smiling, too!...CITs go blasting on the range one night...even Peter

Berk and Joel Robbins get a shot with the "big gun..."Nature and drama classes report to the office..a trip to JR's Petting Zoo, no, Jeff Herschleb, the wildlife is out here, not indoors...Scott Gold likes the gray fox...all liked the rhesus monkey and Froggie's whistle David Hesser shoots another moon when he's not flirting with Lisa...Big bet between Steve Wanty and Cliff Broeniman about barefootin'..The competition is so severe, a petition is signed by 146 peopke requesting that Cliff be allowed to ki at freetime...
