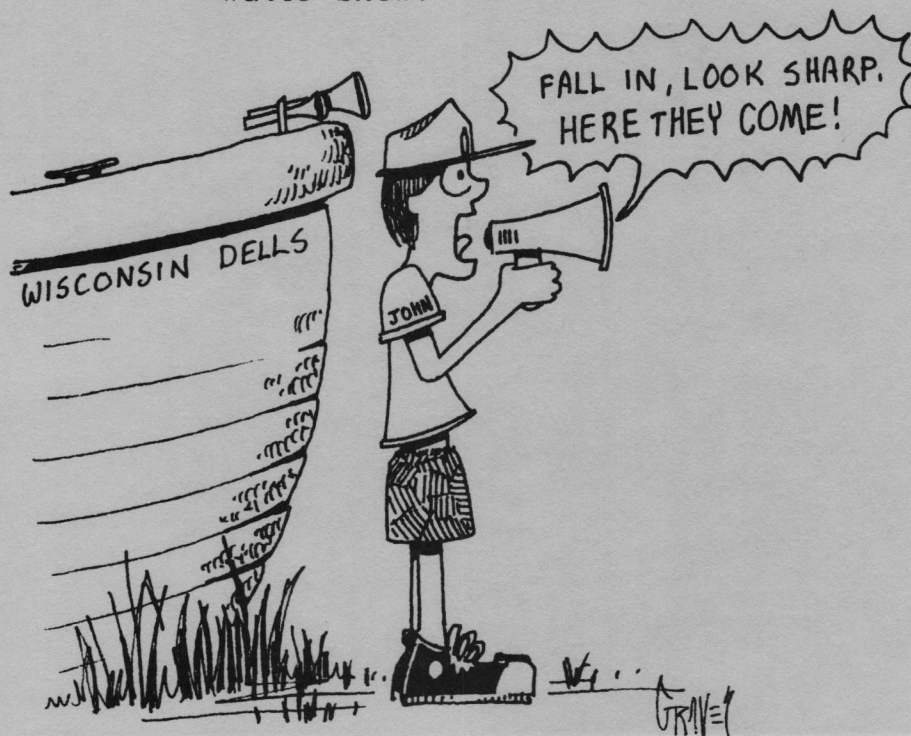
## CAMP WAUPACA
