CABIN 10

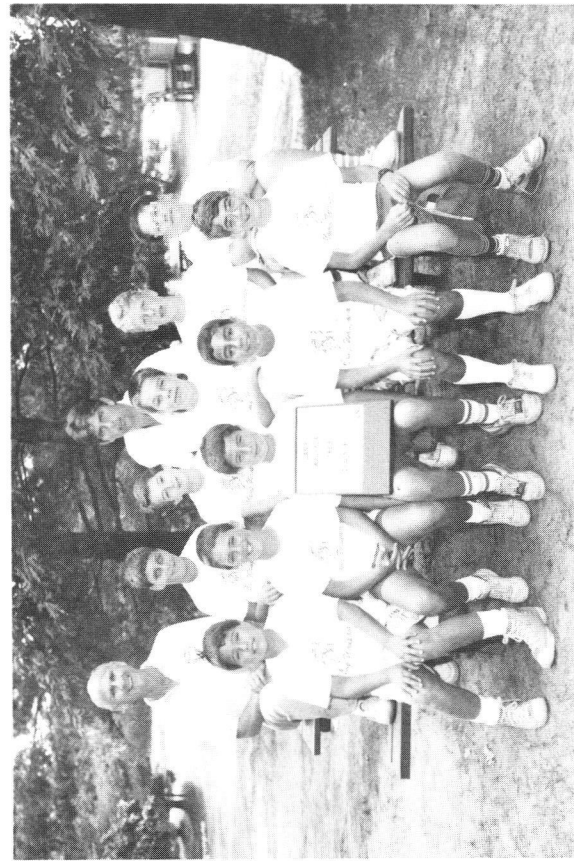
1 AM Dan Schmidt - Turn off the water! turn off the water!!
